ORDER

Dated: December 24, 2007

The Tata Power Company Limited (“TPC”) filed a Petition on October 16, 2007 submitting therein that the Tariff Order (for TPC-D) dated April 30, 2007 in Case No. 70 of 2006 has not permitted the recovery of price variation of expensive power sources through FAC mechanism. TPC has therefore prayed for inclusion of the recovery of price variation of expensive power through FAC mechanism.

2. At the hearing held in the matter on November 21, 2007, it was observed that TPC-D needs to submit a Petition for mid-term review (Annual Performance Review) of its multi-year tariff, based on the actual expenses borne by it from April 2007 to September 2007. The reliefs as sought for under the present proceedings need to be considered during the said Annual Performance Review process.

3. Accordingly, TPC has filed a letter dated December 7, 2007 before the Commission seeking withdrawal of the present petition. TPC has also submitted therein that the aforesaid dispensation has been included by it in their Annual Performance Review Petition.

In view of the above, the Petition filed by TPC is dismissed as withdrawn.
