CLARIFICATORY ORDER

Dated: September 26, 2007

The Commission passed an Order dated April 30, 2007 (Case No. 70 of 2006) in the matter of Determination of Annual Revenue Requirement for the Control Period from FY 2007-08 to FY 2009-10 and Retail Tariff for FY 2007-08 for M/s. Tata Power Company Ltd. Subsequently, on September 7, 2007, the Commission issued a Clarificatory Order for TPC in the context of applicability of LT IV tariff (Advertisement and Hoardings).

The Commission, vide its Clarificatory Order dated August 24, 2007 (Case No. 26 of 2007 and 65 of 2006), clarified the applicability of tariff for Multiplexes and Malls in case of MSEDCL. Accordingly, the Commission is issuing the clarification for TPC in the matter of applicability of LT V tariff for Shopping Malls and Multiplexes.

The fifth paragraph of the approved Tariff Schedule placed in Appendix 4 [Page No. 84-85] of the MYT Order for TPC stipulates the applicability of LT V tariff as follows:

“Shopping Malls and Multiplexes (LT V)

Applicability

Applicable for supply to shopping malls and multiplexes with sanctioned load above 20 kW, taking supply at LT voltages.

This tariff will be applicable also in the event of extending supply to shopping malls and multiplexes at HT voltage”.

For the purpose of applicability of LT V tariff, it is clarified that large shopping/departmental stores like Shoppers' Stop, Big Bazaar, Shop Rite, Spencers, etc., with sanctioned load above 20 kW will be classified under LT V Tariff Category. The clarification given in this Order will come into effect from May 1, 2007.
