STIPENDIARY REGULATORY ANALYST

The Maharashtra Electricity Regulatory Commission (MERC) has been constituted under the Electricity Act (“EA”), 2003. The role and functions of the Commission have been elaborated in the said Act. The functions of the Commission are quasi judicial, quasi legislative and executive. A copy of the Electricity Act, 2003, Regulations specified by the Commission and other related information is available on the Commission’s website www.mercindia.org.in.

The Commission is inter alia mandated to deal with the following task –

- (a) Evaluation and approval of Annual Revenue Requirement (ARR) and Determination of Electricity Tariff/ Multi Year Tariff of Distribution Licensees, Transmission Licensee and Generating Company applicable to the electricity consumers.
- (b) Vetting of Fuel Adjustment Charges (FAC) and examining the capital expenditure proposals of distribution and transmission licensees.
- (c) Proposals regarding procurement / purchase of power.
- (d) Determination of Tariff for Renewable Source of Energy.
- (e) Promotion of co-generation and generation of electricity from Renewable Energy Source.
- (f) Load Shedding etc.

For discharging the said task, the Commission intends to appoint “Stipendiary Regulatory Analysts” in the office of the Commission.

The methodology for carrying out the above task would inter alia include to examine the the proposals received from the Distribution Licensees, Generating Companies, Generator of Renewable Energy and to make suggestion to the Commission in the matter. Initially, the experienced officers of the Commission will guide the

Stipendiary Regulatory Analyst. Subsequently, the work assigned to the Stipendiary Regulatory Analyst will be required to be done by them independently.

2. The eligibility criteria and other terms and conditions for appointment as Stipendiary Regulatory Analyst are as under:-

- Name of Post : Stipendiary Regulatory Analyst
- Number of Posts : 5 (Five) {Extendable upto 10 (Ten) as the Commission may decide.
- A) Qualifications : (i) He/ She must be M.E/M.Tech in Energy Science and Engineering, Power System, and related areas from IIT, NIT and other University/Institute recognized by UGC/AICTE.
Or
(ii) He/ She must be PostGraduate in the Environment Science, Applied Statistics, Mathematics and related areas from IIT, NIT and other University/Institute recognized by UGC/AICTE.
- The candidates who have appeared for the final examination and expecting results shortly may also apply.
 - The candidates having knowledge of Marathi may be preferred.
- B) Age: Maximum 30 years as on 1.06.2009.
- C) Stipend: Rs 12,000 per month (consolidated all inclusive).
(Reasonable increase will be considered for the 2nd and 3rd year based on their performance).
- D) Contract: Initially for One Year. Extendable for Two more

Years on satisfactory services rendered and by mutual agreement.

- ❖ The candidates who will be appointed as “Stipendiary Regulatory Analyst” shall not have any right/ claim or lien for appointment on regular basis on the establishment of the Commission.
- ❖ MERC reserves the right to reject any or all of the applications without assigning any reason whatsoever.
