**Suggestions and objections on DLHPPL's Petition for determination of tariff for
Bhandardara Hydro Power Project-II (34 MW)
(Case No 27 of 2008)**

1. The Dodson-Lindblom Hydro Power Private Limited (DLHPPL) has filed a Petition for determination of tariff for Bhandardara Hydro Power Project-II (34 MW) before the Maharashtra Electricity Regulatory Commission (MERC) under the provisions of Electricity Act, 2003 and the MERC (Terms and Conditions of Tariff) Regulations, 2005. The Commission has admitted the Petition on March 13, 2009 and directed DLHPPL to publish a Public Notice under Section 64 (2) of the Electricity Act, 2003 for inviting suggestions and objections from the Public through this Notice.

3. The Commission has directed DLHPPL to invite suggestions and objections from the public on the above Petition through this Notice.  4. Every person who intends to file suggestions and objections can submit the same in English or in Marathi, in six copies, and should mention the full name, postal address and e-mail address, if any, of the sender, by **Thursday April 9, 2009**. It should be indicated whether the objection is being filed on behalf of any organization or category of consumers. It should also be mentioned if the sender wants to be heard in person, in which case opportunity would be given by the Commission at the Public Hearing to be held **at the office of the Commission, 13th Floor, Centre No.1, World Trade Centre, Cuffe Parade, Mumbai 400 005 on Thursday April 16, 2009 at 11.00 hours**, for which no separate notice will be given.
 5. DLHPPL shall reply to each of the suggestions and objections received within three days of the receipt of the same but not later than **Monday April 13, 2009** for all the suggestions and objections received till **Thursday April 9, 2009**. The stakeholders can submit their rejoinders on replies provided by DLHPPL either during the public hearing or latest by **Wednesday April 22, 2009**.
